RFP for Water Meter Replacement

Each Submittal Package shall be in a sealed envelope addressed to the City of Vidalia and clearly marked "RFP for Advanced Metering Infrastructure System". Submittals will NOT be accepted or considered after the deadline. Submittals will be considered non-responsive if proposing company is not on the "List of Proposers" prior to the bid date.
