- **STREETS & SANITATION COMMITTEE MEETING – July 8, 2026**
Only a second motion is needed to approve the recommendation of this committee:
 - a. Following a meeting of the Streets & Sanitation Committee, it is recommended to enter into an agreement with InfraHub, Inc. for a term of one year at a cost of \$13,000.00 for Video/GPS Data Collection of roads, sidewalk assessments, and pavement striping assessments to create a scoring system for roads to be used to address repair and resurfacing needs. Fund Source will be General Fund.
 - b. A recommendation to approve Resolution 2026-011, Transportation Investment Act of 2010 Project Agreement for 100% TIA funded road projects within the City of Vidalia. There are 17 roads included in TIA Band.
